The Waters Business Park continues to build momentum as the 3rd Master Planned Business Park in the Terracon portfolio. This summer, Terracon and the City of Winnipeg joint ventured to develop 2,600 feet of Mazenod Road and create a future link for Winnipeg's Active Transportation Corridor (ATC).

Landscaping is being installed for both the ATC and Building W-1. The largest of the trees planted this year were reclaimed from the \$5.6 million dollar renovations taking place at Winnipeg's historic Central Park. These trees were destined for the chainsaw before Terracon offered to transplant 10 of these trees, including 6 basswood, 3 shuber & chokecherry and 1 patmor ash.

Spring 2010 will promise to be Blooming!











Tuxedo Business Park continues to expand! The Tim Hortons building and Buildings 11 and 12 were completed and leased in 2009. With this growth brought the extension of Commerce Drive and additional public green space to the Park. Tuxedo Business Park now offers over 22 acres of parks and green space to its tenants and visitors.







Summer 2009 also brought change to our most established Park. The City of Winnipeg, as part of a \$5.0 million dollar upgrade to Dugald Road, will be installing control signals at the entry to Terracon Business Park. In addition, Terracon Place has been widened to allow for a full right hand turn lane heading west.
